

Davis High School Community Council Minutes

September 6, 2017, 6:30 a.m.

Dianna Barton welcomed the Council. Minutes from the August 16th meeting were approved. Shanna Barker was elected as Assistant Chairperson, and Lance Thaxton as Secretary. Council members were asked to complete member training.

Mr. Wilkey reported that last year's budget expenditures totaled \$259,900 last year. This year's expected budget with carryover funds from last year is \$261,616.47. He also shared with the Council that the Kaysville City Manager, Shane Scott, would like to establish a committee to improve communications between the city and schools within the city boundaries. He asked for a member from each school community council to participate. Julie Taylor volunteered to be part of the committee.

Andrew Thaxton (Student Body President) reported that the Davis High theme this year is Be Bold with Brown and Gold. The student officers are trying to get students involved in clubs and school activities. Last week they held a successful club rush week, and plan to hold another rush week in October. Homecoming Week is October 2-7. He identified one of the challenges that the student body faces is finding a place to fit in. Caden Karras (Senior Class President), Tom Mi (Junior Class President), and Luke Bowers (Sophomore Class President) stated that the strengths of Davis High include academics, sports teams, and the community support.

Mr. Wilkey identified two new school goals: improve ACT scores and increase use of Canvas.

Mr. Chapple reviewed the prior year's status report and this year's school goals:

1. ACT/SAGE testing improvements;
2. Maintain whole school graduation rate while increasing subgroup graduation rate;
3. Professional development;
4. Student academic needs; and
5. Meet emotional/psychological student needs.

For each of the above goals, the following Council members will be part of focus groups:

1. ACT/SAGE testing (Gregg Laub (lead), Brad Chapple, Shanna Barker, and LeAnn Wood);
2. Graduation rate (Shanna Barker (lead), Greg Wilkey, Alan Porter, Kim Humpherys);
3. Professional development (Tyson Smith (lead), Greg Wilkey, Bradley Chapple, Gregg Laub);
4. Academic needs (Dorothy Watkins (lead) Dianna Barton, Lance Thaxton, LeAnn Wood);
5. Emotional/psychological needs (Kim Humpherys (lead), Dianna Barton, Julie Taylor, Alan Porter).

Bradley Chapple requested \$2700 to pay for professional development at the DSD Summer Institute-Teacher2Teacher Conference. The request was unanimously approved with Gregg Laub motioning to approve, and Lance Thaxton seconding the motion.

The next meeting on September 13, 2017 at 6:30 a.m. will focus on the proposed school boundary.

Shanna Barker motioned to adjourn the meeting, and Gregg Laub seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned.
