DAVIS HIGH SUMMER DRIVERS ED 2023



Registration for summer Driver's Education at Davis High School will begin on Monday, April 10, 2023 in the main office. You must have your Learner's Permit with you to register. The student also needs to bring their permit with them the first day of class. The fee for the class is \$160, due at the time of registration. To sign up for the summer class students must turn 16 before January 1, 2024

There will be six summer classroom sessions offered this year (27 spots per class):

Session 1: June 5-15 - 7:00-10:00 am

Session 2: June 5-15 - 10:00 am-1:00 pm

Session 3: June 19-29 - 7:00-10:00 am

Session 4: June 19-29 - 10:00 am-1:00 pm

Session 5: August 1-11-7:00-10:00 am

Session 6: August 1-11 - 10:00 am-1:00 pm

State law requires students to be in class for 27 hours. You cannot miss a day or leave early for any reason. If this happens, it is an automatic fail and your money is not refunded. If you have questions please contact Mr. Sims at chsims@dsdmail.net

Students will drive with a road instructor for six hours in addition to the classroom hours and course work. This will be scheduled with the student during the class and may be completed during the summer months.

Requirements to receive a Utah Driver's License:

- 1) 16 years old
- 2) Permit for 6 months
- 3) 40 driving hours with a parent (10 at night)
- 4) State On-line Test (dld.utah.gov)
- 5) 6 driving hours with an instructor
- 6) Driving Test with an instructor
- 7) 27 classroom hours
