
*You should have received a school email to sign up for a time if you want to begin filling out college applications in Lab 1101 on October 5 or October 6.

We recommend that you keep a login and password sheet so that you can get back into any application you haven't finished. University of Utah* (apply for free through Common App during October!)

<u>Utah State University</u> Open House- Monday, October 19, 3:00-8:00pm, Davis Conference Center, 1651 N. 700 W., Layton. This is a great opportunity for your students to meet with the USU admissions staff, learn more about housing, majors, financial aid and scholarships. Also, for those students who qualify for an academic scholarship, if they bring their **ACT**, **Official HS Transcript and apply before they come**, they can receive an academic scholarship on the spot.

<u>Utah Valley University*</u> (apply for a discounted fee if you attend their open house!) Weber State University

***if you are a concurrent enrollment student at Weber State,, you just need to make a Status Switch on your Wildcat page. Weber State Status Switch instructions

Westminster College* (apply for free using Common App or Westminster application during October!)

Step #2: SEND YOUR Davis High TRANSCRIPTS!

Step #3: SEND any College TRANSCRIPTS with CE credit!

Log onto your Wildcat page if you have Weber State CE credit and search for "Online Transcript Ordering."



College Application Essay Tips:

Are you writing an essay for a college?

- Save the essay and the essay prompt. Some colleges use the same prompt and if you have the essay saved, you won't have to rewrite it!
- Be original in your essay remarks. Show the admission board who you are and give them an insight into what you will become.

Going Right to Work after High School?

Follow the instructions below!

Go to Keys to Success and complete the Reality Check activity.

- Select an occupation (and use the occupation's salary for your budget). Use this to search for a career that really interests you. Select the career and then click on the Go to Reality Check button at the bottom of the career options.
- Work through the budget activity and see if you can afford everything you want on the salary you make. Review the budget and explore matching occupations.
- Can you afford everything? Either way, check out some of the technical schools below and see if there is a short term program you do to earn a certification.
 Certifications typically help you earn more money because of the additional training required.

Step #1: Every student should Apply for the FSA ID

Apply for a scholarship today during UCAW!

Get started! Make a list of all the great things about you; this will help you during the application process. Scholarship committees are looking for students who:

have financial hardships



- are engaged in the community through service/volunteer work
- have demonstrated leadership skills
- are culturally diverse
- have overcome hardships
- are outstanding athletes
- have high index scores

Be the student that is deserving of scholarship funds and be sure to thank those who offer you scholarship money. Don't assume so many students are applying that you don't have a chance. You'd be surprised; apply!

Find Scholarships online: You can <u>Search for Scholarships</u> on the Davis High webpage. which is updated by Mrs. Sommer. It is a great list of scholarships to explore. Another list of great scholarships can be found at https://www.completescholarships.org/

Do you know what a scholarship index is? It is a graph with your GPA and ACT/SAT scores that shows you admissions and scholarship information for colleges. Check out some of these admission indexes available for colleges in Utah.

Scholarship Websites: When you are searching for scholarships, there are a lot of websites that you can use. Most of these websites will have you create an account and input information about yourself like your GPA, extracurricular activities, college preferences, college majors, etc. Creating a profile will help match you with scholarships you are interested in. NEVER PAY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP WEBSITE TO HELP YOU FIND SCHOLARSHIPS.



The more scholarships you apply for, the more money you stand a chance of winning for college!

Receiving Scholarships: make sure to notify the Scholarship Specialist, Teresa Sommers, of any scholarship offers you receive this year. You can email her or stop at her desk in the Counseling Center.

Create Your Portfolio Portfolio

Do you have at least 2 letters of recommendation? If not, work on getting them from a teacher, counselor, coach, etc. <u>Letter of Recommendation Form</u>

List of Accomplishments - do you have a list of service, awards, leadership roles, other accomplishments prepared? If you don't, work on creating one!

- Emails from your college open them and stay informed about:
 - o Financial Aid they may request that you verify your FAFSA info



- Tuition deadlines
- Scholarship Offers
- o Orientation before school, first day or before registration?
- Scholarship deadlines stay focused and don't miss them!
- Housing Application Deadlines how early are they?
